

There aren't many items to report this month, although some of them are important for the future development of the museum. I will list the items as follows:

- Behlen Building. Bill will probably report on negotiations with Behlen and some of the rehabilitation plans. In the meantime a list of items needed for its future use are: Electricity; New sliding doors or overhead door; Roof rehabilitation; inside insulation and heating; windows, where broken.
- We will move the workshop and some tractor storage to the Behlen Building. The former shop and Garage will be prepared for housing the Carl Bolt collection. For this the garage will have to be rehabilitated first.
- We received a donation of a shock absorbing steering wheel from Roger Welsch and have sent a letter of thanks to his home in the Liars Capital. I haven't decided or discussed yet where we will display this steering wheel, which is a Nebraska development made by Kosch Company of Columbus. We have received materials on the wheel from Kosch and from and old article in Green Magazine. - Test Car location. We will plan to build a lean-to type annex for the Test Car before it will be handed over to us. We expect this to be happening sometime next spring or early summer. TTL
