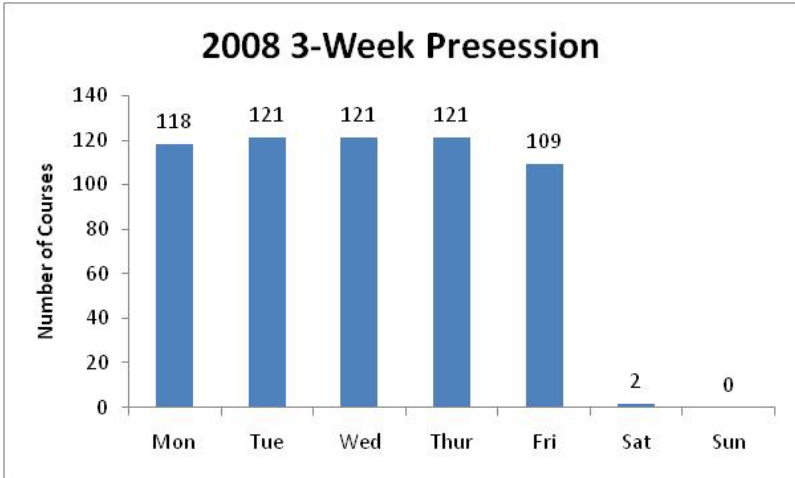

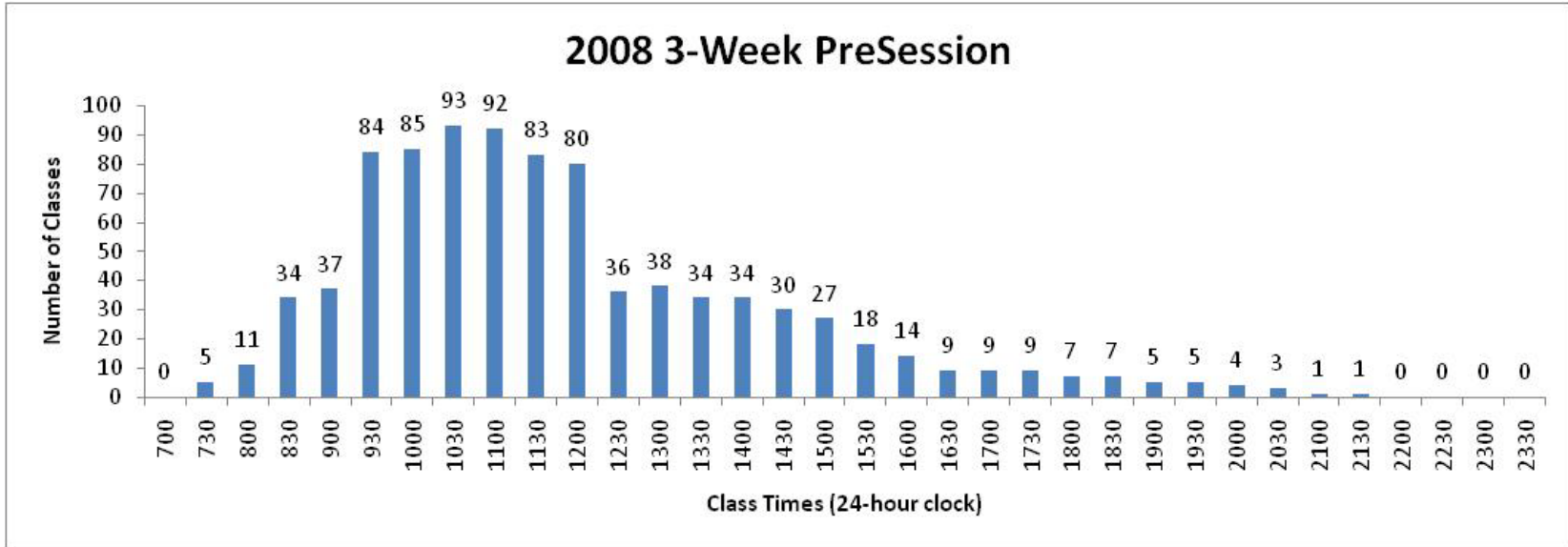

# 3-Week PreSession

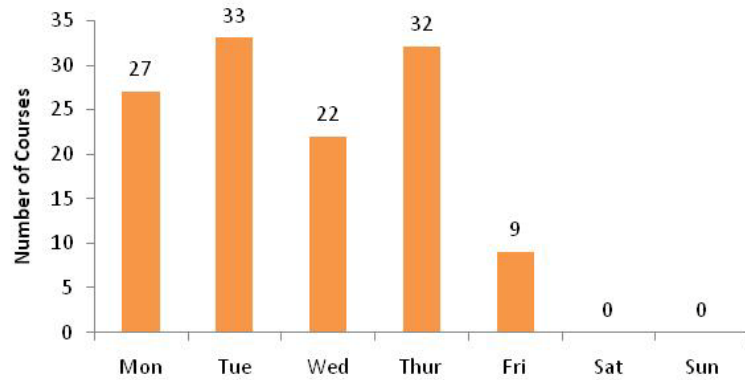


Classes evenly distributed between Mon to Thursday with some decline in Friday class sessions. Most courses scheduled between 9:30 am and noon.



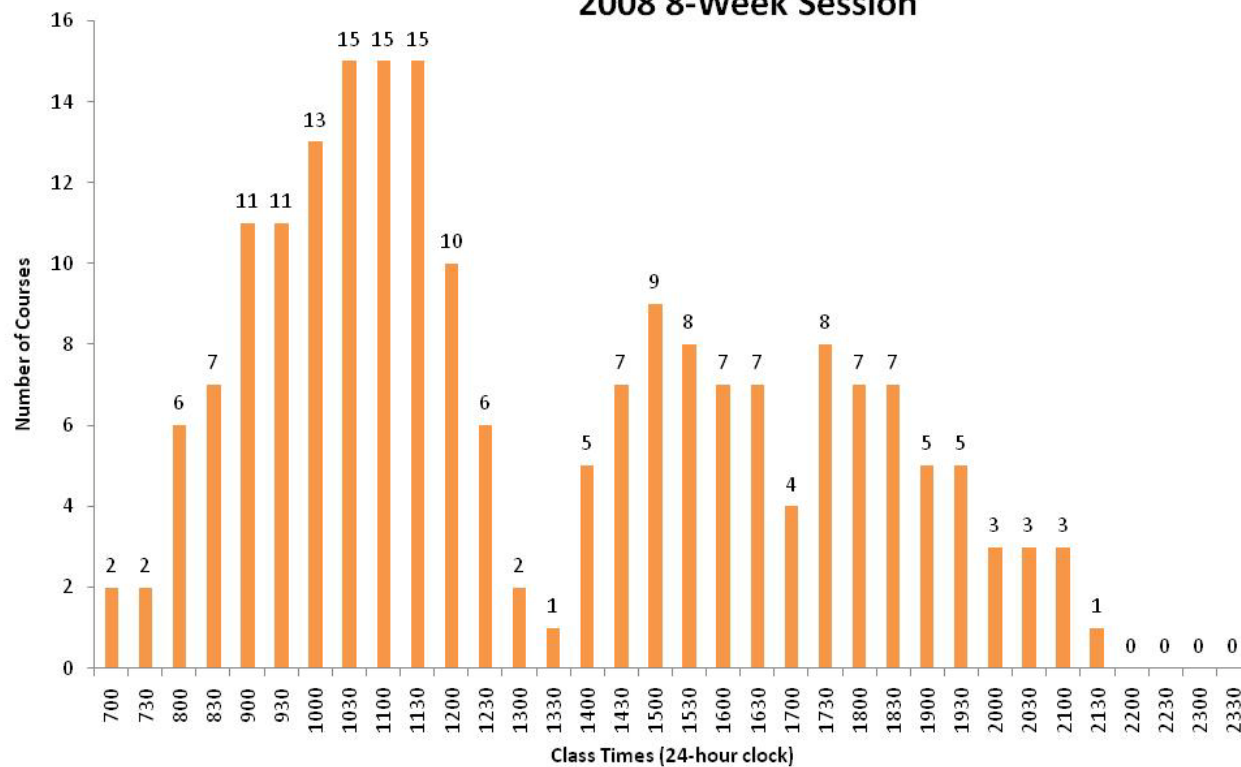
# 8-Week Session

### 2008 8-Week Session

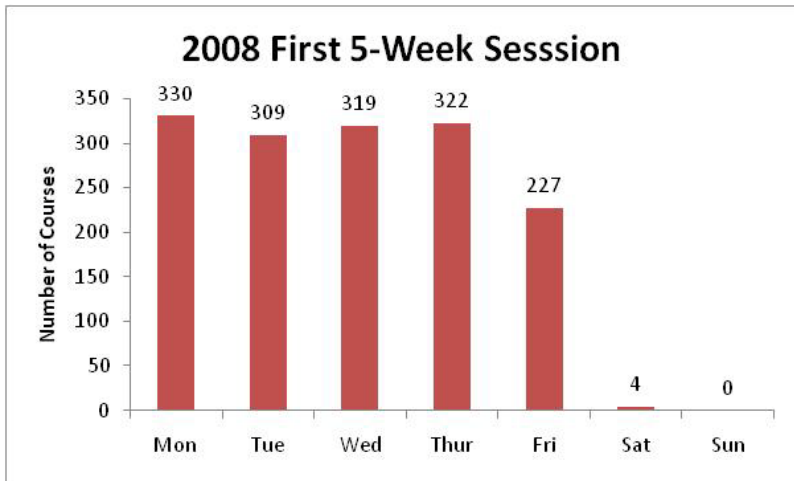


Classes mixed between Mon/Wed and Tue/Thur. A large decline in Friday offerings. Many classes scheduled between 9:30 am and noon.

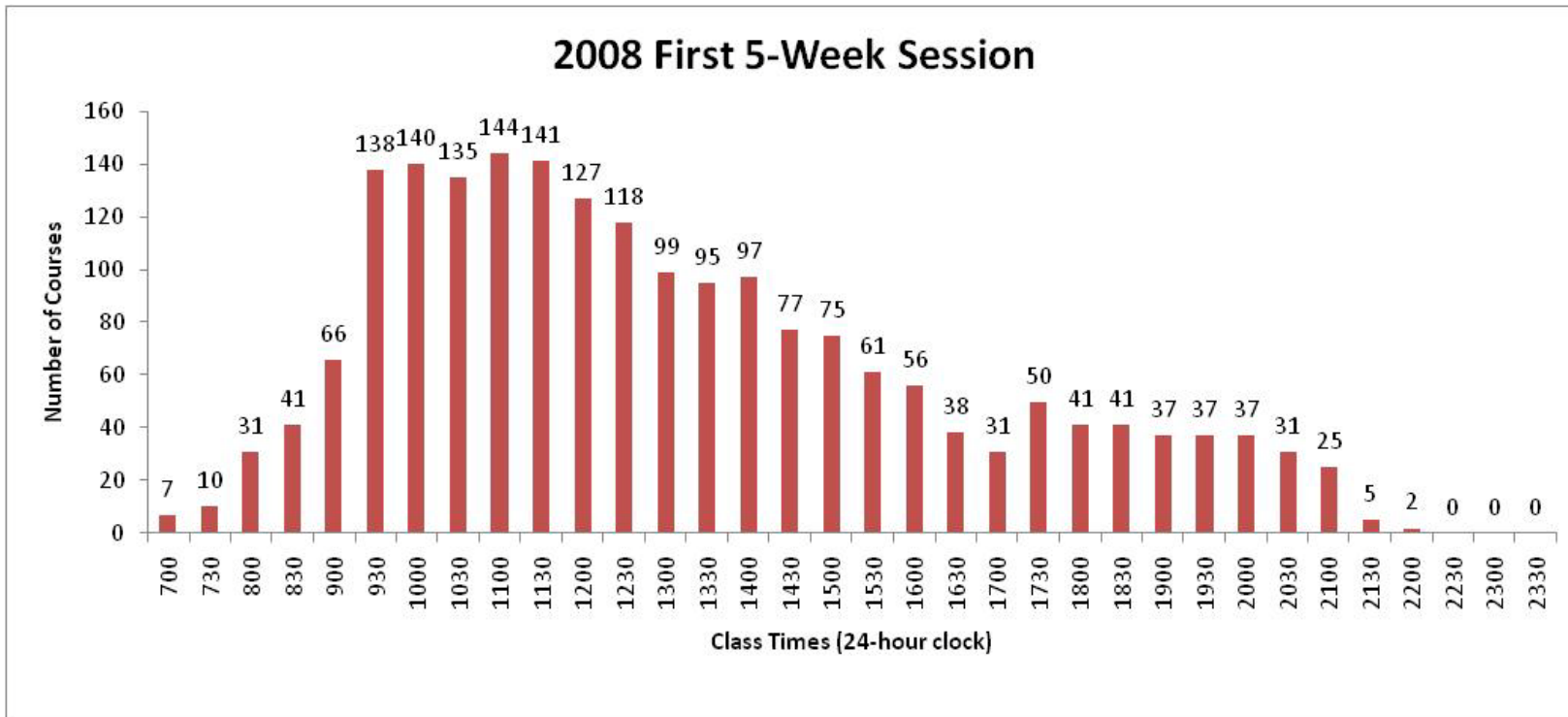

# First 5-Week Session

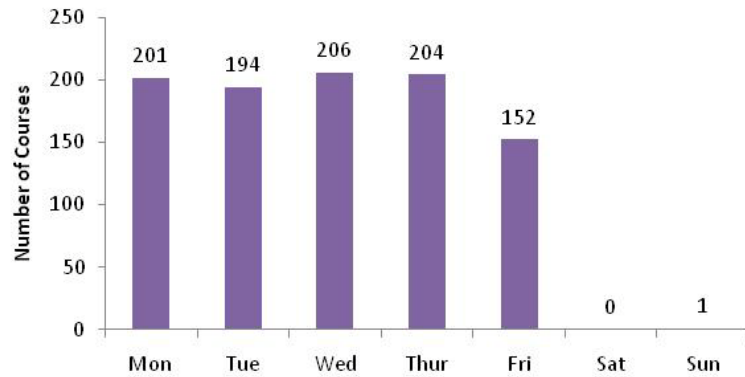


Classes evenly distributed between Mon to Thursday with some decline in Friday class sessions. Most courses scheduled between 9:30 am and noon.



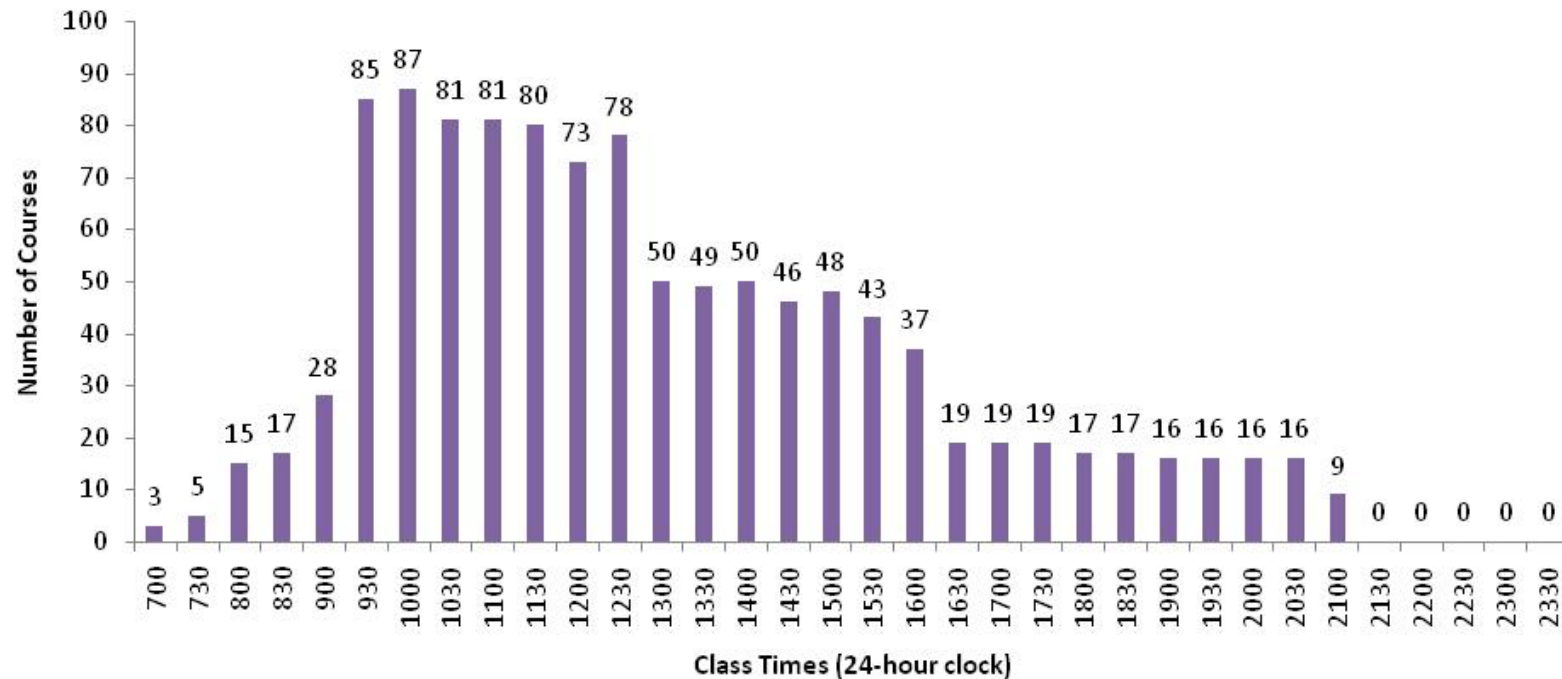
# Second 5-Week Session
