Bylaws (Jane Schneider) made a motion to update Standing Rule #1's renewal date to correspond with the current Bylaws for Article III – Membership, Sect. 3. Cathy Robertson seconded the motion.

Standing Rules #1: Membership shall be for the fiscal year July 1 to June 30. Membership fees are due July 1 each year. The membership fees are \$15.00 for active members, \$15.00 for associate members and \$2.00 for retired members. A life membership fee is \$200.00. Members who have not renewed their membership by **September 30** will be removed from the active member list and lose full membership privileges.

University-wide Benefits (Diane Wasser) reported that Open Enrollment will be Nov. 19-Dec. 7, 2012.

Premiums for the upcoming year have not been determined, but will most likely go up due to the addition of the Employee Plus One benefit.

Health Risk Assessment (HRA) survey will start Nov. 19 through the ESS system. If you complete this survey you will receive enhanced wellness and preventive services benefit in 2013.

Employee Plus One will be offered for the first time and will become effective Jan. 1, 2013.

Healthcare reimbursement account contributions will be reduced from \$5000 to \$2500 per employee starting in 2013.

As part of the Uniform Coverage Documents a Summary of Benefits and Coverage (SBC) will be provided to all benefit eligible employees.

The prescription drug plan has several changes. Caremark is encouraging you to use generic drugs whenever possible.

EyeMed Vision Care has gone paperless. You will no longer receive your Explanation of Benefits in the mail. You will have access to them electronically through the website. You can change delivery to paper on the website.

Life Insurance will be able to be increased by completing a proof of insurability form online through the Assurity Life Insurance security website.
