Meeting called to order by Chair Splinter at 1:45 p.m. in 225 Chase Hall.

Motion to make Dr. Estes a committee member as the new UNL Museum Director was passed to replace Genoways.

West half of the roof has been repaired. Many more roof joists were replaced than anticipated. Cost was \$20,000 over the original bid. About 50 alumni have responded to our fund drive for supporting the roof repair.

Bob Kleis suggested we make up an organization with a known board, officers, and friends group.

Franklin Walters asked about the policy for volunteering for or in the museum.
