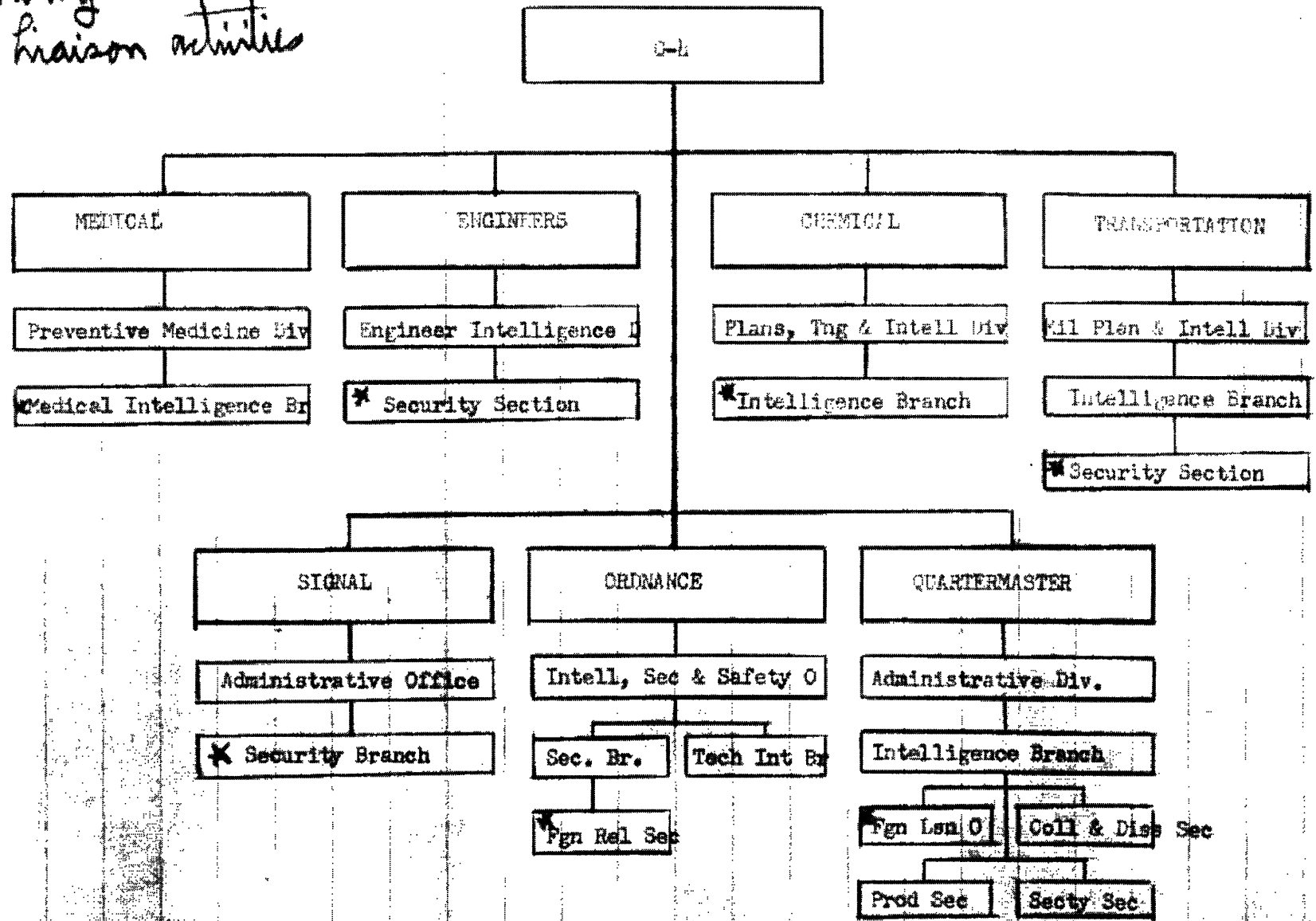

SGO required to establish and maintain an intelligence unit, under the principle of decentralization stated in par 3, SR 10-5-1 and letter CS&ID 310.11, 19 Aug 1947, "Intelligence Relationships Between the Intelligence Division and the Technical Services." CONFIDENTIAL

SGO was assigned responsibility for medical intelligence matters by letter AS&ID-S 723 (21 Mar 48) CS&ID-M, 29 March 1948, "Intelligence on the Health and Mortality of Foreign Countries." CONFIDENTIAL

SGO responsibility for providing medical intelligence for the Army is stated in par 21d, SR 10-340-1.
