US Army Area Analysis Intelligence Agency is ESTABLISHED with Hq at the Army Map Service, 6500 Brooks Lane, Washington 25, D.C as a separate agency, ASSIGNED to Chief of Engineers, all effort and projects in the field of area analysis intelligence now being performed in the Army Map Service, Board of Engineers for Rivers and Harbors and the Beach Erosion Board are ASSIGNED to US Army Area Analysis Intelligence Agency effective 27 Jul 1962 - GO 15, Office of the Chief of Engineers, 25 Jul 1962. CONFIRMED and DESIGNATED as a Class II activity - GO 47, DA, 26 Jul 1962. Also see - GO 1, Corps of Engineers, US Army Area Analysis Intelligence Agency, 27 Aug 1962.
