## UNL CAMPUS POLICE COMMITTEE

### NAME AND MEMBERSHIP

The UNL Campus Police Committee shall consist of two faculty members appointed by the President of the Faculty Senate, two students appointed by ASUN, one administrator appointed by the Chancellor, and two employees selected by the office and service staff of UNL. Terms of faculty members shall be two years.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

The Committee shall assist (1) in the determination of codes of ethics in the enforcement of campus security regulations and policies on violations thereof; and (2) in an advisory role in the selection and review of the chief police officer analogous to the faculty input on administrative evaluation and review.
