

Objectives

In January of 1963, UNOPA was founded upon these objectives:

- ◇ To encourage educational personnel to continue in their professional growth through the National Professional Standards Program (PSP), sponsoring workshops for both members and nonmembers, and promoting participation in the Nebraska Educational Office Professionals Association (NEOPA) and the National Association of Educational Office Professionals (NAEOP).
- ◇ To identify employee concerns, especially those that affect the office/service classifications, and to work within the University system to meet those concerns.
- ◇ To encourage all members to interact with and learn from one another through mentoring programs, classes, and workshops, to serve on various University or UNOPA committees, and to develop leadership skills by heading committees and serving as officers of the Association.
- ◇ To encourage all members to broaden their understanding of the University of Nebraska, its goals and functions, and the relationship between the University and the community.

Attendance

The Chancellor supports administrative leave being granted for attendance of UNOPA activities and committee meetings, with approval from your immediate supervisor.

Membership

Membership is open to persons interested in promoting the objectives of the Association. UNOPA has five classifications of membership:

- 1) Active Members—office personnel in the educational system of the University of Nebraska. They are entitled to vote, hold office and participate in all activities of the Association.
- 2) Associate Members—persons who are interested in advancing the objectives of the organization but who are not eligible to be active members. They pay dues and have the rights and privileges of active members except those of voting and holding office.
- 3) Retired Members—retired UNOPA members who desire to keep in touch with the Association and the University community. They have the right to vote and may serve on committees.
- 4) Life Members—active members who have paid life membership dues. They have the same rights and privileges as active members.
- 5) Honorary Members—individuals who have made significant contributions to the growth of UNOPA, its members and office/service employees, and are conferred with the approval and majority vote of the Executive Board. They do not pay dues yet are entitled to all the privileges of active members with the exception of the right to vote and the right to hold office.

Communication

UNOPA NOTES, the monthly newsletter, keeps our membership informed by offering communication about the calendar of events, membership information, meeting topics, professional growth articles and activities, and minutes of the last meeting.
