Location of Registered Irrigation Wells in Nebraska as of 1972

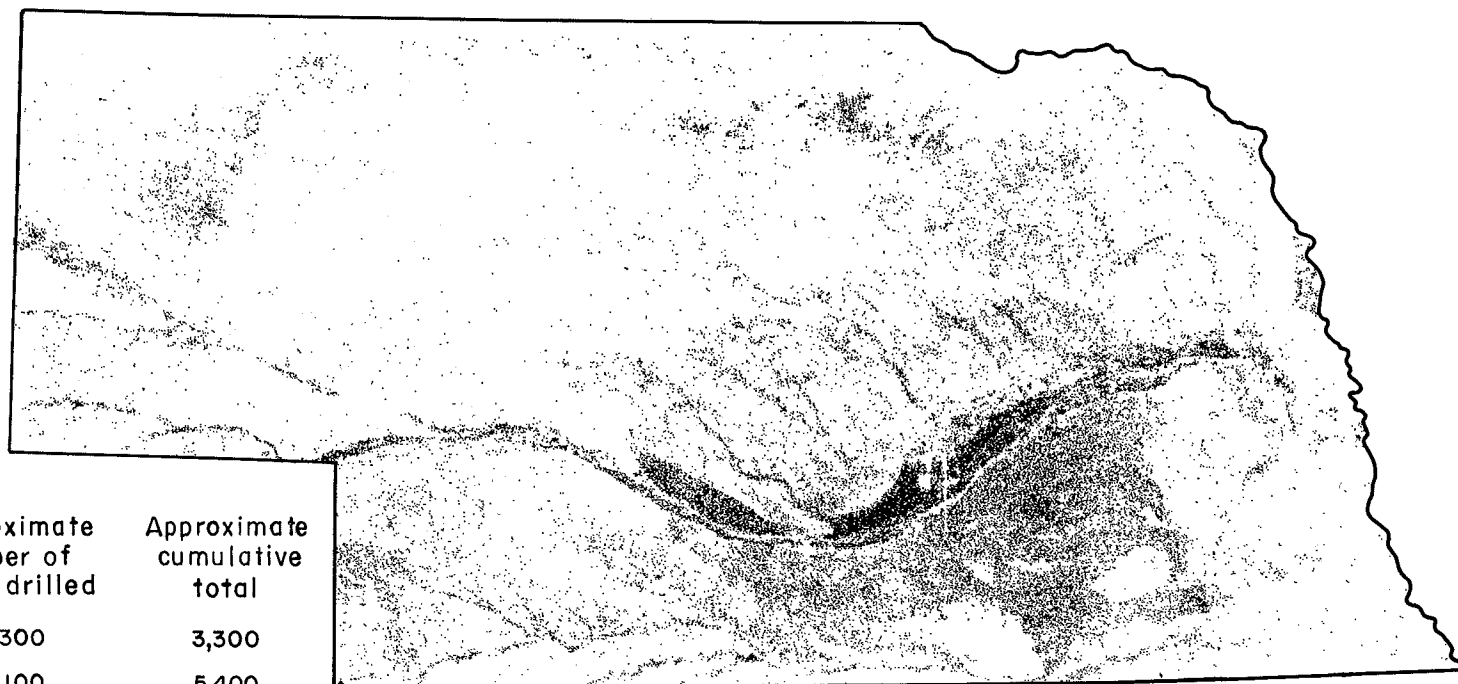
