Oklahoma Botanical Literature. By Forrest L. Johnson and T. H. Milby. Norman: University of Oklahoma Press, 1989. Literature citations, indexes. 150 pp. \$22.50.

Johnson and Milby have produced a valuable bibliographic aid for the serious student of the flora of the southern Great Plains. The listing, in one place, of 862 references from such diverse sources is a major contribution by itself. The addition of indexes for authors and subject-in-context greatly increases the utility of this reference book, making it easy to search among all 800-plus citations for ones of particular interest. This book should find a home in biology libraries across the region.
