Total length of manuscripts, including notes and illustrations, should not exceed thirty pages, but shorter contributions will be preferred. All copy, including notes and captions, should be double spaced. References in the notes should conform to the mode specified in *The Chicago Manual of Style*, 13th ed. rev. (Chicago: University of Chicago Press, 1982). See especially chapters 15, 16, and 17. Manuscripts should be accompanied by two duplicate copies and a stamped, self-addressed envelope. Blind review procedures are followed for all contributions to the *Quarterly*. The decision to publish an article rests with the editor in consultation with associate editors.
