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MANY MINDS MADE LIGHT WORK this year as I distributed just over 130 reviews across eighty reviewers. Almost all the forty-five reviewers from Volume 27 of To Improve the Academy served again for this volume, and dozens of new colleagues volunteered to join us. I was amazed at the quality of the vast majority of the reviews: detailed and specific, helpful to the authors, methodologically savvy, substantively rich covering content to wording, and long (one to four pages single-spaced). Although the reviewers didn't always agree about a given manuscript, they explained the values and standards they used to arrive at their recommendations.
