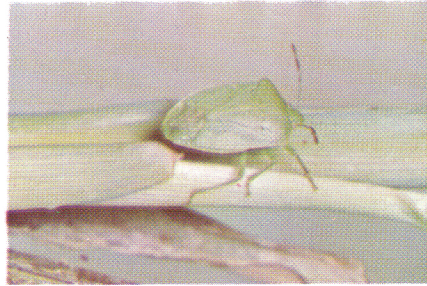

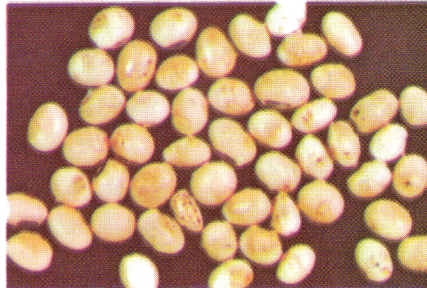

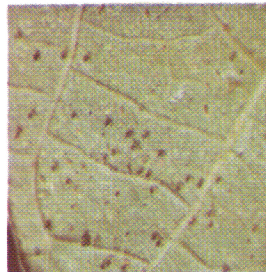
6. Two-spotted mite
