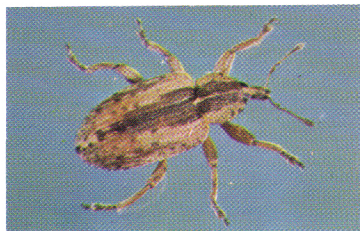

2. Clover leaf weevil larva



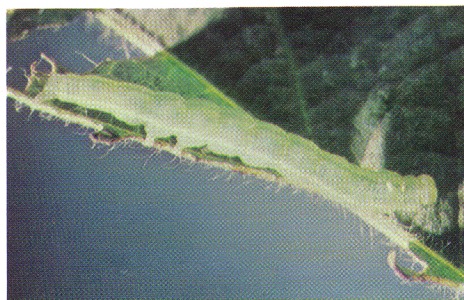
3. Sweetclover weevil and typical damage



4. Variegated cutworm



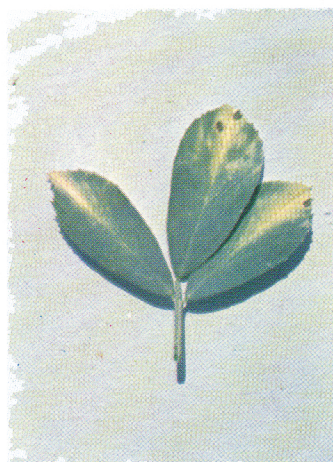
5. Grasshopper
