## CONTRIBUTORS TO THE MARCH ISSUE

FREDERICK K. BEUTEL, Professor of Law, College of Law, University of Nebraska, received his A.B. at Cornell University in 1921 and his LL.B. and S.J.D. at Harvard University in 1925 and 1928 respectively. Dean of Nebraska College of Law, 1945-1949; Editor, 5th, 6th and 7th edition of Brannan's Negotiable Instruments Law, 1932, 1938, 1948; Materials and Cases on Negotiable Paper, 1936; Bank Officer's Handbook of Commercial Banking Law, 1939; Materials and Cases on Uniform Commercial Law, 1950.

WILLARD B. COWLES, Professor of Law, College of Law, University of Nebraska, received his A.B. in 1928, LL.B. in 1932, Ph.D. in 1942, all at Columbia University. Graduate fellow, international law, Harvard Law School, 1932-1933. Advisor on international law to Honduras Commission in Guatemala-Honduras boundary arbitration, 1931-1933. Attorney, general claims arbitration between U. S. and Mexico, 1934-1937; Special Assistant to U. S. Attorney General, 1941-1942. Advisor on international law in Judge Advocate General Department. Attached to Office of U. S. Military Attache, U. S. Embassy, London, 1944. Consultant, U. S. Delegation, U. N. War Crimes Commission, London, 1944. Engaged in private practice until 1947 when he joined the Faculty of Law, University of Nebraska.

JAMES A. LAKE, Assistant Professor of Law, College of Law, University of Nebraska, received his A.B. at the University of Nebraska in 1943 and his LL.B. at Harvard University in 1946. Now doing graduate work at the University of Wisconsin. Law Clerk for Judge Calvert Magruder, Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals for the First Circuit, 1947; Senior Law Clerk for Justice Harold H. Burton, United States Supreme Court, 1947-1949; Assistant Professor of Law at the College of Law, University of Nebraska since 1949.
