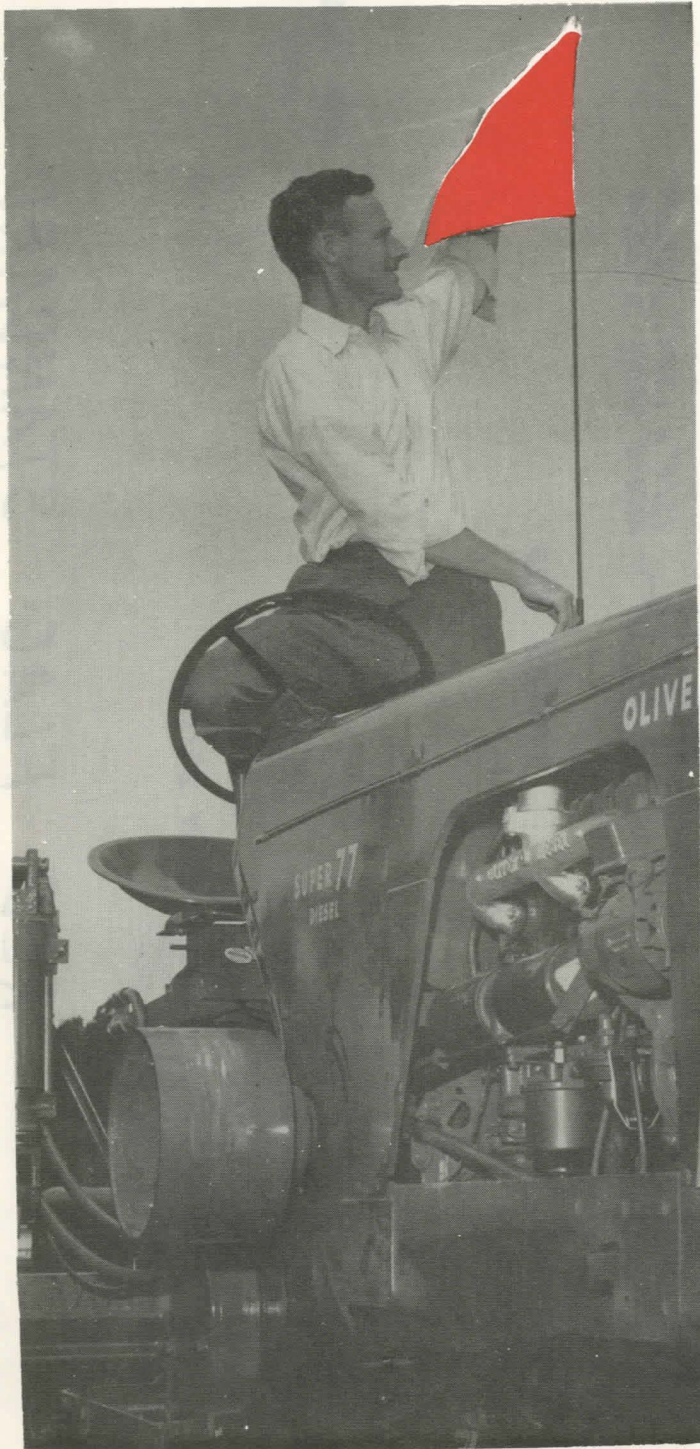

A **red** flag on your tractor may save your life!

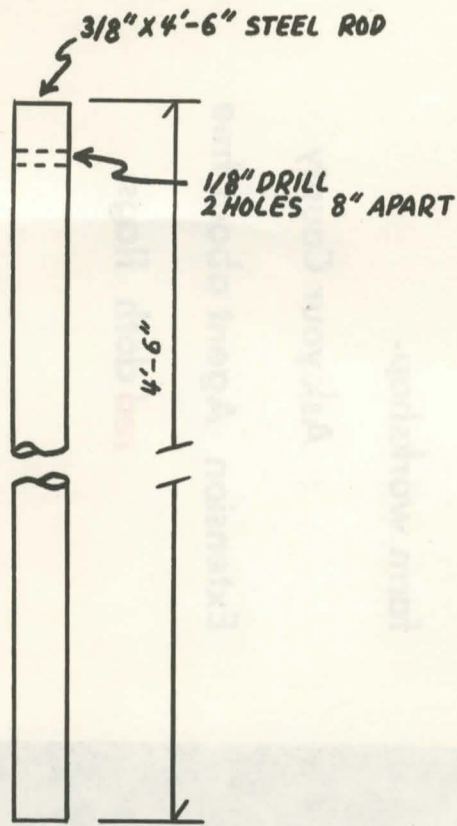
A **red** flag eight feet above your tractor will tell motorists there is slow moving equipment ahead.

The **red** flag and standard can be purchased commercially or can be made in your farm workshop.

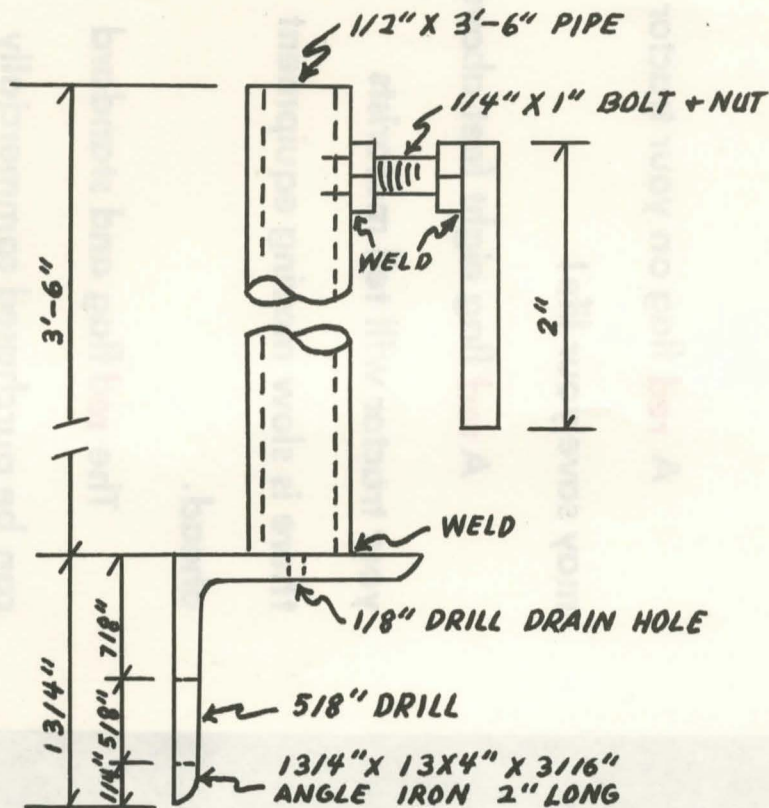
Ask your County Extension Agent about free **red** cloth flags.

UPPER ROD



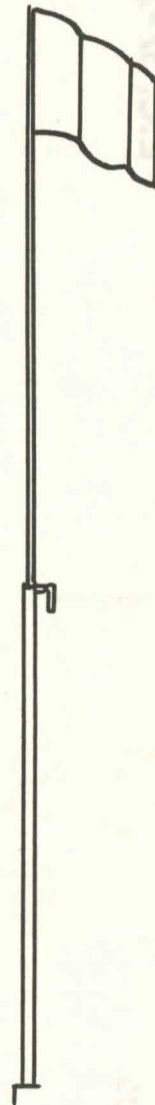
LOWER ROD

BILL OF MATERIALS

- 1- 3/8" X 4'-6" STEEL ROD
- 1- 1/2" X 3'-6" PIPE
- 1- 1 3/4" X 13/4" X 3/16" ANGLE IRON 2" LONG
- 1- 1/4" X 1" MACHINE BOLT + NUT
- 1- 1/4" X 2" ROD FOR WING BOLT
