Pole- and Panel-Construction

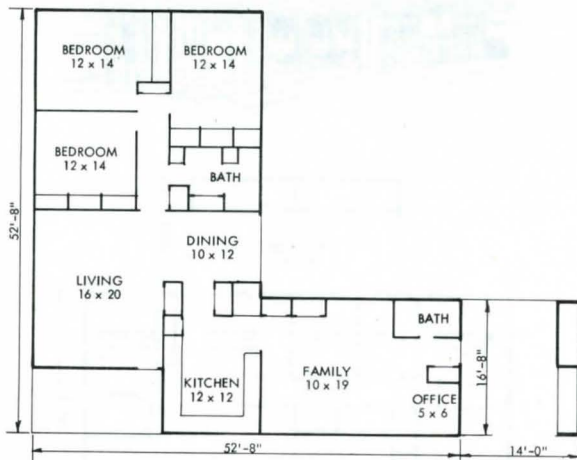

Basement, 1590 sq ft

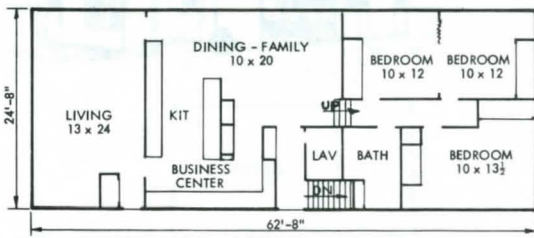

Lower Level, 576 sq ft

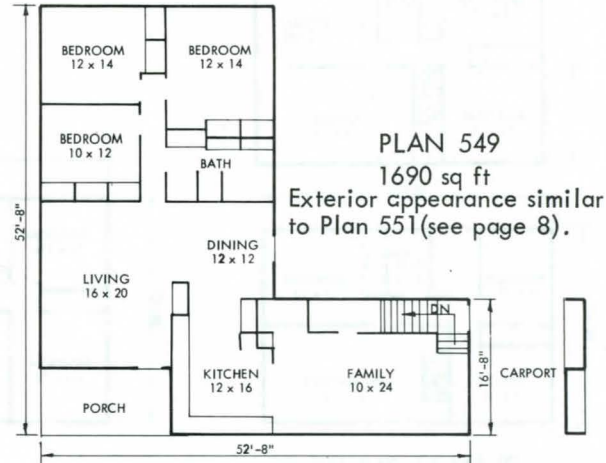
