This is a project evaluation for Team 14 the Solar Power Charging Station. For the first section I gave a 3.87/4 for several reasons. The positives for this section are that they did a good job explaining all the data of their project and is done so in a way that the audience had a clear understanding of the project. However, the team did have a more difficult time presenting the timeline and additionally they did not provide more specific information into the design constraints which need to be more specific so that parameters for the project can be met. The next section to be covered is the Organization section and for this section I gave a 4/4 and the reasoning for this is the presentation is organized in a way that is easy for the audience to follow along with, data is sequential and slides that are followed sequentially have data that can relate to the previous slide or start a new topic of discussion which is again easy for the audience to follow along with, and finally none of their slides worked backward in the presentation and no data was skipped over which is an overall success. The next section to cover is the Presentation section and for this I gave the team a 3.9/4 and some of the positive reasons were that they spoke with both a technical aspect and a down to earth aspect which made understanding the project amongst all parties easier, the visuals were not distracting from the data and emphasized and strengthened the overall presentation, and finally they added figures that were not necessary, but added to the overall understanding of the work they put into this project. However, the team did have some visuals that were hard to read and due to this it was distracting and additionally there was inconsistent volume control and pausing which was distracting to the overall presentation. The final section to discuss is the Q/A Session and for this section I gave a 4/4 for the reasoning that they answered all questions the audience had and did so in an effective way. The overall score I gave to this team was a 3.9425/4 which is extremely high.
