Attached are six prints of the Waterloo Boy which were taken a couple of weeks ago. We have many additional shots, of course, and if you would like any additional angles and/or prints, we would be most happy to furnish them to you upon your request.

Two 500 ft. drawbar tests were run while we were there and the one was just short of 3 ft. of making the prescribed distance. While this can hardly be called an official test, the tractor did crank out, according to your fellows, 16.91 drawbar h.p. which comes down to around 12.68 when you take the 75%.

To date, we have not made mention anywhere of this test and I don't know where or how many places we might use it. However, I promise that you will have an opportunity to see any and all copy before it actually gets into print.

Once again I would like to thank you and Mr. Larsen for making your facility available to us, and we hope that we did not interrupt any of your work in the process.
