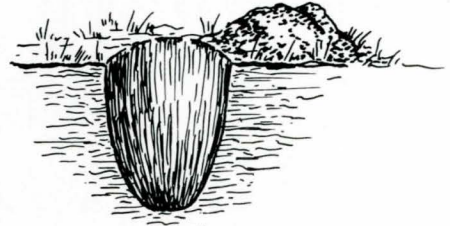

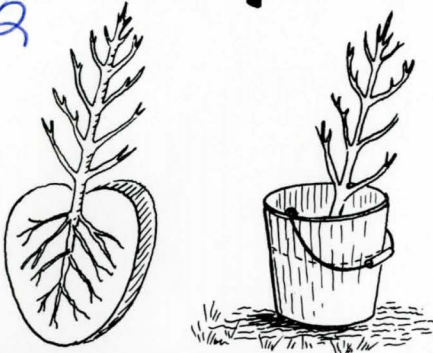

2. HAVE HOLE DEEP ENOUGH AND WIDE ENOUGH TO ACCOMMODATE ROOTS IN A NATURAL POSITION.



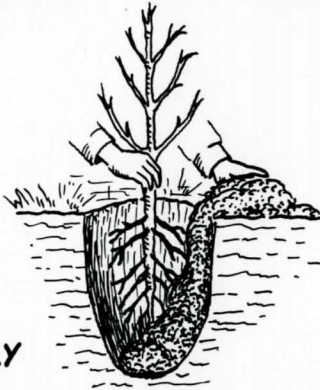
1. UNPACK TREES IMMEDIATELY & PLACE IN BUCKET OF WATER OR THIN MUD. DO NOT PLANT WITH PACKING MATERIAL ATTACHED TO ROOTS. DO NOT ALLOW ROOTS TO DRY OUT.



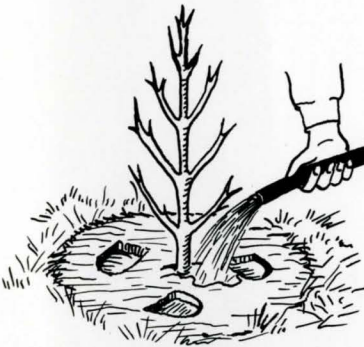
4. SHOVE IN THE REMAINING SOIL AND PACK FIRMLY WITH THE HEEL.



3. PLANT TREE SLIGHTLY DEEPER THAN IT STOOD IN NURSERY WITHOUT CROWDING THE ROOTS. PARTIALLY FILL HOLE & PACK THE SOIL FIRMLY AROUND LOWER ROOTS.



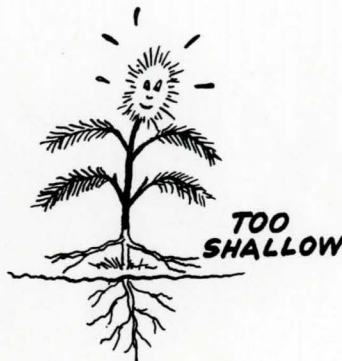
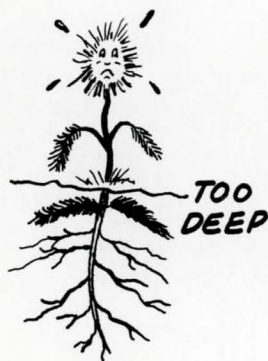
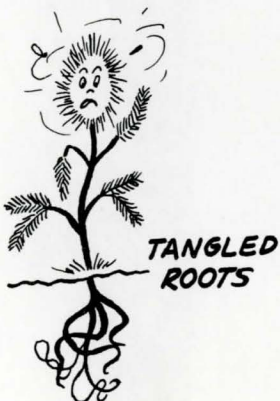
5. GIVE THE TREE PLENTY OF WATER.
