### **Summary**

Historical Data Cards were used to record the organizational history of units within the Army. This card was provided to Robert Bolin by the US Army Institute of Heraldry in 1985.

The Chemical Corps Intelligence Agency (CCIA) established by Sec. II, Department of the Army General Orders 27, 15 April 1955. CCIA was a Class II organization subordinate to the Chief Chemical Officer. It was charged with performing the intelligence functions of the US Army Chemical Corps.

In 1962, the CCIA was absorbed by the newly created US Army Foreign Science and Technology Center.

Chemical Corps Intelligence Agency is ORGANIZED at Gravelly Point, Washington, D. C., as a class II field activity, assigned to the Chief Chemical Officer and 5702d Technical Service Unit is ASSIGNED - GO 27, DA, 18 Apr 1957. CONFIRMED - GO 3, Office of the Chief Chemical Officer, 18 Apr 1958. AMENDED - GO 14, Office of the Chief Chemical Officer, 8 Aug 1958, and GO 11, Office of the Chief Chemical Officer, 18 Nov 1958.

Chemical Corps Intelligence Agency is REDESIGNATED US Army Chemical Corps Intelligence Agency effective 1 Jan 1957 - AGAO-O (M) 322 Tables of Distribution (19 Oct 56) DCSPER, 13 Nov 1956. AMENDED - AGAO-O (M) 322 Tables of Distribution (25 Feb 57) DCSPER, 4 Mar 1957. CONFIRMED - GO 10, DA, 21 Feb 1957.

Enlisted personnel are ATTACHED to Hq, US Army Garrison (8617), Arlington Hall Station - Ltr, GAS21-300, US Army Security Agency, 6 May 1958. Effective 10 May 1958 - GO 3, US Army Garrison, Arlington Hall Station, 8 May 1958.

TD 03-9702-00 is WITHDRAWN and TD 03-1402 is ASSIGNED effective 1 Mar 1959 - GO 5, Office of the Chief Chemical Officer, 16 Feb 1959.
